RIDE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All participants must obey the directions of the trail boss, scouts and staff.
- NO PUBLIC DISPLAY OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- Shoes recommended. Non-skids on scout horses.
- NO GLASS CONTAINERS ALLOWED ON TRAIL.
- NO SMOKING WHILE RIDING ACROSS RANCHES.
- Button badges must be worn and visible at all times. All adults and children riding and/or camping must be current registered riders whether joining for one day, several days or entire event.
- **CAMPSITES MUST BE LEFT CLEAN.** Do not leave hay on ground. Scatter manure. No littering in camp or on
- No rowdy or unruly behavior on horseback or in camp. No unattended or uncontrollable animals will be allowed on the ride. Violators may be asked to leave without a refund.
- Current Coggins is required for every equine on the ride. Vaccinations for VEWT prior to ride recommended. YOU MUST HAVE PROOF OF NEGATIVE COGGINS WITH YOU ON ENTIRE TRAIL RIDE.
- Pets must be kept on leashes and kept under control. Owners must have pets' current vaccination papers with them on ride.
- Kicking animals must have a red ribbon on the tail.
- No riding double except for adults with young children.
- Minors must be accompanied by an adult.
- No loud music late at night.
- Generators should be muffled and of reasonable noise level.
- Park your rig in a manner that will prevent your equine from causing damage to vehicles and other animals.
- No firearms may be carried by any trail riders.
- Western style clothing preferred.
- Equines may not be tied to any fences along the route. Violators will be responsible for paying any damages.
- Drainage of "black water" from trailers onto ground is prohibited.
